Fermilab Education Facilitators will lead group activities, and we rely on you to help students behave appropriately and ensure their safety. Once you arrive at Fermilab, an Education Facilitator will meet your group and give you more specific information about the activities and schedule. Chaperones and group leaders are responsible for the safety and behavior of their group during the visit.

Important Reminders:

- o Always remain with your assigned group.
- o Help keep the group together, particularly when moving between activities or sites.
- o Model engaged learning by only using your cell phone in case of emergency.
- o Encourage student participation and explore along with them.
- Assist students with activities but don't tell/give them the answers.
- o Monitor behavior and correct any inappropriate behavior.
- o Oversee and assist with lunch, especially clean up.
- Supervise group during bathroom breaks.
- Failure to adequately supervise your group may result in your group being asked to leave.
- Students are not allowed electronic devices during the visit. If a group photo is requested, we ask that you assist in organizing the students.
